

How to do puppetry "home alone"

Course outline

Blind Summit's expertise is in three person puppetry, but we're not allowed to get together and do that right now.

So what can we do?

This workshop will focus on everything that you can do at the moment to improve your puppetry skills, and make some puppetry while you are locked down or working in small support bubbles.

You will learn puppetry exercises you can do on your own, or with one or two other people, to improve your puppetry technique.

Ideas for making puppetry work on your own.

Puppetry inspiration to read and watch.

Plus a short surgery on questions that you have about your own puppets or puppetry sequence you are working on.

Puppet Surgery: an opportunity to share your puppets, puppet problems for one on one advice session

Experiments and Discussion Session: On puppetry and performing potential on Zoom, how can we best use it to make live performance?
